



Millgrove Cemetery Price List – Effective April 1, 2025

The terms Resident and Non-Resident are defined in the Cemetery's By-Laws. Plots purchased after February 28, 2022, may contain 1 full casket plus 2 urns. Additional urns may be added to a plot for \$500 per urn. The total number of burials per plot cannot exceed 8 urns and 1 casket.

Each plot purchased, includes administration fees and standard cornerstones. Upgraded granite cornerstones may be purchased through the Cemetery and are charged at the Cemetery's cost. An installation fee of \$125.00 applies for a set of granite cornerstones.

Scattering Garden Fees:

Per Urn - \$530

A scattering garden was established in 2022. For those wishing to have some or all their endof-life cremated remains placed in the Millgrove Scattering Garden, scattering rights may be purchased. This right will allow ashes to be placed and in the Scattering Garden (only) and the person's name to be entered on to a stone memorial located on either side of the Garden. The cost for the stone lettering is borne by the rights holder.

The lettering style and font must conform to the Cemetery's Bylaws for consistency purposes. Scattering Garden engraving must be done through the Cemetery. Ask for a lettering quote from the Cemetery as volume discounts may be available for multiple inscriptions. In all cases, a \$35 handling fee will be charged by the Cemetery to coordinate and arrange the lettering.

Casket Burial Fees:

Excavation fee for a casket - \$1100 Plus HST plus a cemetery administration fee of \$530. Included in the cemetery admin fee is a charge of \$100 to cover the cost of earth removal from the cemetery.

While a vault or liner is recommended for casket burials, should a family wish to forgo a vault or liner, there is a \$350 surcharge above the administrative fee to cover the costs of tending to future excessive grave settlement. If no vault/liner is chosen, families are reminded to ensure that your Funeral Director orders graveside coverings and a lowering device for the casket.





Urn Burial Fees:

Cremation Urn burial - \$555 per urn, \$885 for 2 urn family interment conducted on the same date and time. (\$100 premium for Saturday cremation burials.)

In addition to the Urn burial fee, an additional winter excavation fee applies once the ground is frozen - \$600 (to cover the cost of additional equipment)

Cremation Urn <u>Disinterment</u> fees - \$555 per urn (undertaken only when the ground is not frozen).

Purchase of Additional Cremation Interment Rights:

\$500 per urn per plot to maximum number of 8 urns per plot (see Cemetery By-Laws)

Millgrove Cemetery's Care and Maintenance Fund Requirements:

As per the cemetery's by-laws and in accordance with the provisions of the Ontario Funeral, Burial and Cremation Services Act, the Cemetery shall place 40% of the plot, scattering rights and/or additional cremation rights purchases into the Cemetery's Care & Maintenance Fund. This fund is managed by the Cemetery's Financial Trustee. Fee submission percentages may be altered as stated on the Bereavement Authority of Ontario's Care & Maintenance Fund schedule.





Other Fees:

Fee to Register an Additional Name on a plot previously sold: \$75.00 a person. (Must have plot owner's or family's permission)

All burials – Sunday or Statutory Holidays must be pre-approved (\$150 premium if approved)

Tree Removal Charge Due to Encroachment and Removal Requests - \$100

Monument/Marker Staking fee for monument delivery - \$50.00

Depending upon the size of the monument, a Monument/Marker Care and Maintenance Regulation Levy is charged prior to monument installation – the charge is determined as per the Funeral, Burial and Cremation Services Act of Ontario, 2002 and updated by the Bereavement Authority of Ontario.

Plot rights ownership transfer fee on non interred plots - \$400 as per Cemetery By-laws and in accordance with the provisions of the Ontario Funeral, Burial and Cremation Services Act.





The Millgrove Cemetery offers a plot care service. Prices start at \$85 to landscape a standard sized monument that includes plants, mulch, and weeding. Contact the Cemetery for further information. If you have multiple monuments, a discounted quote can be given for multiple plot sites.

The Millgrove Cemetery offers a monument re-leveling service. If you have a flat monument that is sinking or an upright monument that is somewhat leaning, please contact us for a quote.
